Church Council Members

Members of the congregational council shall consist of no more than 13 voting members elected by the congregation.

Term of office is two years. Members can be elected to serve no more than 3 full consecutive terms.

Nominating Committee

Nominate 5 voting members

The nominating committee consists of 5 voting members of the congregation, at least two of whom are outgoing members of the congregational council. The nominating committee is not eligible for consecutive re-election.

Audit Committee

Audit committee members may not be members of the congregational council, finance committee, or the executive committee. Term of office is three years, with one member elected each year. Members are eligible for re-election.

Voting Members, Synod Assembly

Nominate a total of 3 voting members

The three nominees are to be two men and one woman or two women and one man. The Pastors are automatic voting members for the Assembly. No information as to re-election.

Mediation Board

Nominate 3 voting members

This board term is for one year. Members are on stand-by until a dispute arises. Employees and current council members are not eligible to serve on mediation board. No information on re-election but it has been customary that is okay to re-elect consecutive years.

Endowment Committee or Legacy Giving

Nominate necessary members to the committee each year for the five-member total.

Three year term: maximum of two consecutive terms. After a lapse of one year a person may be re-elected. A Pastor and President and/or Vice president of the congregation shall be advisory to the committee.
