

A narrative budget is the story of our congregation's ministry. It is a true story of how our resources are spent. It is more than just account names and numbers. A narrative budget explains the expenditures that carry out our mission statement, **"Rooted in God's grace, we joyfully witness and serve."** It shows how your monetary gifts become grace through our witnessing and serving.



The above pie chart shows how the money received by Mount Cross was translated into ministry and mission this year. The pie is divided

- into four pieces: + Worship and Music
  - + Faith Formation for All Ages
  - + Service and Missions
  - + Caring

The percentage of the budget that is dedicated to these areas of ministry is shown in the pie chart. Continue reading to find out more about what our resources support!

NOTE: A large portion of the budget goes to paying salaries for the church staff. These salaries are distributed across the four designated areas of the pie chart according to the percentage of time each staff member spends working in each area. The same is true for property costs, insurance, utilities, and office expenses.
